Dear Warren Tech Parents and Students,

Young drivers are involved in fatal crashes at more than twice the rate of all others. Traffic crashes are the leading cause of teen fatalities, accounting for 44% of teen deaths in the United States. The first year for a newly licensed teenage driver is the most dangerous, with more than one in five involved in crashes. Something needs to be done.

**Alive at 25** is a highly interactive 1 session **four-hour** program that encourages young drivers between the ages of 16 and 24 to take responsibility for their driving behavior. Skill practices and on-the-spot defensive driving techniques help change bravado to confidence. Warren Tech is fortunate to have Trooper Tom Walsh administer the course. During our students high school career he acts as an invaluable support. As the course administrator, he uses workbook exercises, interactive media segments, group discussions, role-playing, and short lectures to help young drivers develop convictions and strategies that will keep them safer on the road.

This year all Warren Tech students who intend to drive to school and utilize the school's parking lot must attend Alive at 25. Upon completion of Alive at 25, students will earn a certificate that many insurance companies honor with a discount. The schedule for Summer 2009 is as follows:

At the start of the 2009-2010 school year any student who completed Alive at 25 must bring their valid drivers license, vehicle registration, and insurance card to the main office to be issued a parking permit. Please note ANY student who will be licensed over the course of the 2009-2010 school year, and plans to drive to school must take Alive at 25. They will be required to bring the above information in once they receive their license.

The cost of the program is \$10 which covers the cost of the student manual and certification. Should there be any unexpended funds they will be applied towards Project Graduation for the class of 2010.
