COURSE OVERVIEW



The New Jersey State Police, Office of Emergency Management North Regional Unit will be instructing a two-day course that has been developed to better prepare school systems to face the threat of a variety of hazards. Topics will include emergency planning, safety, non-structural mitigation, school violence, and disaster response and recovery. This course is intended for school superintendents, school administrators, school principals, facility managers, police administrators, fire administrators, and OEM personnel.

This course will be offered regionally and/or locally for your convenience.

The course has been designed to group policy makers from various disciplines (Schools, Police, Fire, EMS, OEM) in order to facilitate comprehensive emergency planning. This course will provide a well-rounded understanding of emergency planning from the variety of perspectives each discipline brings to the course.
